Food for Thought	from Father Stephen
<b>The Cost of Discipleship</b>	
<p>Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a German Lutheran theologian, wrote a series of reflections on the Sermon on the Mount entitled, <i>The Cost of Discipleship</i>, in which he maintained that discipleship requires that we make a fundamental decision to follow Jesus and to accept the consequences of that decision. His own religious convictions led him to stand up to the tyranny of Nazi Germany and to participate in a plot to assassinate Adolf Hitler. The plot was uncovered, Bonhoeffer was apprehended, and the ultimate “cost” of discipleship was exacted of him: he was hanged by the Nazis on April 9, 1945.</p> <p>While discipleship might force some people to decide between life and death, few of us will be asked to pay that ultimate price. But today's Gospel challenges us to live in a certain way, imitating the prophetic vocation of Jesus (Dianne Bergant, C. S. A.).</p>

### The Grand Séminaire de Montréal and the Séminaire de Saint-Sulpice

The Grand Séminaire de Montréal was established in 1857 on the Mission de la Montagne's old fortifications dating from 1675. Explore the oldest areas of this site dating back to New France, discover the centennial wing, the chapel, as well as the parlour and explore the crypt of Sulpician priests, which is rarely open to visitors! **Guided tours until September 1.**

The Séminaire de Saint-Sulpice, located at the heart of Old Montreal, is the most ancient building in the city having still the same owners since being built in 1683. ### "Aura: The Luminous Experience" at Notre-Dame Basilica

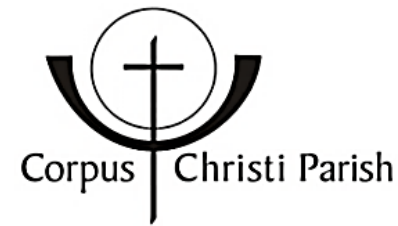
