July 13 – **Saint Henry**, “Good King Henry II”, patron of Benedictine oblates, kings and the physically challenged

[July 14 – Memorial of St. Kateri Tekakwitha (USA), celebrated here April 17]

July 14 – **Saint Camillus of Lellis**, priest, founded the nursing Order the Congregation of the Misters of the Sick (Camillians or Fathers of a Good Death)

July 15 – **Saint Bonaventure of Bagnoregio**, Franciscan, Seraphic Doctor of the Church

July 16 – **Our Lady of Mont Carmel**, principal feast day of the Order of Carmel (Carmelites) on the traditional date on which the Blessed Mother appeared to Saint Simon Stock and gave him the brown scapular (1251)

July 20 – **Saint Appolinaris of Ravenna**, Bishop, one of the first great Martyrs, mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles

July 20 – **Saint Margaret of Antioch**, Martyr, one of the "Fourteen Holy Helpers" and one of the saints that appeared and spoke to Ste Joan of Arc.

July 21 – **Saint Lawrence of Brindisi**, Capuchin Franciscan, Priest, diplomat, missionary, Doctor of the Church

July 22 –FEAST, **Saint Mary Magdalene**, faithful disciple of Jesus, first witness of the resurrection of Christ, patron of the Order of preachers (Dominicans)

July 23 – **Saint Bridget of Sweden**, mother, Franciscan tertiary, Cistercian Religious, founded the Order of the Most Holy Savior (Bridgettines), mystic, visionary, patron of widows and of Sweden, and co-patron of Europe

July 24 – **Saint Sharbel Makhlūf (Charbel Makhlouf)**, Maronite hermit, priest

July 25 – FEAST, **Saint James**, “the Greater”, apostle, bother of John the Evangelist, “sons of thunder”, fishermen, patron of Spain and of pilgrims

July 25 – **Saint Christopher**, one of the "Fourteen Sainted Helpers," highly venerated since ancient times in both the Eastern and Western Churches.

July 26 – FEAST, **Saint Anne and Saint Joachim**, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Einstein’s little neighbor

When Einstein fled Nazi Germany, he came to America and bought a two-story house within walking distance of Princeton University. There he entertained some of the most distinguished people of his day and discussed with them far-ranging issues from physics to human rights. But Einstein had another frequent visitor. She was not, in the world’s eyes, an important person like his other guests.

Emmy, a ten-year old neighbor, had heard that a very kind man who knew all about mathematics had moved into her neighborhood. Since she was having trouble with her fourth-grade mathematics, she decided to visit the man down the block to see if he would help with her problems. Einstein was very willing and explained everything to her so that she could understand it. He also told her she was welcome to come anytime she needed help.

A few weeks later, one of the neighbors told Emmy’s mother that Emmy was seen entering the house of the world-famous physicist. Horrified, she told her daughter that Einstein was a very important man, whose time was very valuable, and shouldn’t be bothered with the problems of a little schoolgirl. She then rushed over to Einstein’s house, and when Einstein answered the door, she started trying to blurt out an apology for her daughter’s intrusion – for being such a bother. But Einstein cut her off. He said, “She has not been bothering me! When a child finds such joy in learning, then it is my joy to help her learn! Please don’t stop Emmy from coming to me with her school problems. She is welcome in this house anytime.”

The evening includes Eucharistic Adoration, prayerful music, scripture, and reflection.


