PRAYER VIGILS FOR LIFE

Wednesday Nights at Corpus Christi



This August, Brian Jenkins, Outreach Coordinator for the Quebec Life Coalition, has pledged himself to pray continuously from sunset to sunrise, Thursday, August 1, to Saturday, August 31. He is dedicating these nights, the prayers and the sleeplessness, to the glory of God, relying on the Lord's strength, provision and wisdom to change hearts and minds about abortion particularly in these moments of great trouble when abortion's shockwaves unsettle so many people. As part of this campaign, he will spend Wednesday nights at Corpus Christi, from 8 pm August 7, 14, 21 and 28 through Thursday mornings. Parishioners are welcome to join him. Together, in prayer, the culture of death can be confronted, aiming to restore our society to a culture of life, one that defends faith, family, and the human person, from conception to natural death. Adoration will mostly be silent, though allowances can be made for other forms, such as recitation of the divine office, hymns, or other devotions. Brian will also include particular needs of our parish community in his nocturnal prayers.

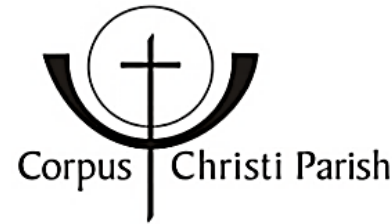
