

## ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

#### August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

- August 4 Saint Jean-Baptiste Marie Vianney, Curé of Ars-en-Dombes, renowned confessor, Patron of parish priests
- August 5 **Blessed Frédéric Janssoone**, Franciscan, negotiated for and built stations, churches, and sanctuaries in Jerusalem and helped develop the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary (Notre-Dame-du-Cap) near Trois-Rivières
- August 5 Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Rome (the Liberian Basilica)
- August 7 Saint Pope Sixtus II and Companions, Martys
- August 7 Saint Cajetan, Priest, founded the Congregation of Clerks Regular (Thetines),

#### August 6 – Feast – THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

Celebrating the transfiguration of Jesus where he became radiant in glory upon a mountain, in sight of three of his disciples, Peter, James, and John. Along with the Baptism of Our Lord, this is one of two feasts of <a href="Theophany">Theophany</a> in the New Testament, from the Greek meaning "manifestation of God." These two feasts show the divinity of Christ and mark the explicit presence of all three persons of the Blessed Trinity: God the Father spoke from heaven; God the Son was the one being transfigured, and God the Holy Spirit was present in the form of a cloud. It is connected with the Jewish Feast of Booths or Tabernacles (remembering how Peter said he would erect three tents), which was a harvest feast.

- August 8 **Saint Dominic de Guzman**, Priest, founded the Order of Friars Preachers (Dominicans), spread devotion to the use of the rosary to strengthen people's spiritual life; Patron of the Dominican Republic, astronomers, scientists and the falsely accused
- August 8 **The Fourteen Holy Helpers**: Saints Acacius of Byzantium, Barbara, Blaise, Catherine of Alexandria, Christopher, Cyriacus the Martyr, Denis of Paris, Erasmus, Eustachius, George, Giles, Margaret of Antioch, Pantaleon, Vitus. These saints were invoked with special confidence in the past because they proved themselves efficacious helpers in adversity and difficulties. The feast was dropped after Vatican II.
- August 9 Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein), Carmelite, Religious, Martyr, co-patron of Europe
- August 10 **Saint Lawrence of Rome**, Deacon, Martyr, patron of cooks, paupers, archivists and librarians
- August 11 **Saint Clare of Assisi**, founder of the Order of Poor Ladies (Poor Clares), patron of television (communications)
- August 12 Sainte Jeanne France de Chantal, wife and mother, founder of the Congregation of the Visitation of Our Lady (Visitationists) for lay women who did not wish the full life of the orders
- August 13 Saints Pontian and Hippolytus, Pope and priest, Martyrs
- August 13 Blessed Michael Joseph McGivney, priest, founded the Knights of Columbus
- August 14 Saint Maximilian Kolbe, Franciscan, Priest, Martyr
- August 15. Feast THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Proclaims the divinely revealed truth that the Immaculate Mother of God, on the completion of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heaven

August 16 - Saint Stephen of Hungary, King, patron of Hungary

#### ABOUT PRAYER

We continue to find out about prayer and how it can enrich our spiritual lives, from in the Compendium of the Catholic Church, Section Four, on **Christian Prayer** (#534 – 598)

#### PRAYER IS FULLY REVEALED AND REALIZED IN JESUS

#### 541. From whom did Jesus learn how to pray?

Jesus, with his human heart, learned how to pray from his mother and from the Jewish tradition. But his prayer sprang from a more secret source because he is the eternal Son of God who in his holy humanity offers his perfect filial prayer to his Father.

#### 542. When did Jesus pray?

The Gospel often shows Jesus at prayer. We see him draw apart to pray in solitude, even at night. He prays before the decisive moments of his mission or that of his apostles. In fact, all his life is a prayer because he is in a constant communion of love with the Father.

#### 543. How did Jesus pray during his passion?

The prayer of Jesus during his agony in the garden of Gethsemani and his last words on the cross reveal the depth of his filial prayer. Jesus brings to completion the loving plan of the Father and takes upon himself all the anguish of humanity and all the petitions and intercessions of the history of salvation. He presents them to the Father who accepts them and answers them beyond all hope by raising his Son from the dead.

#### 544. How does Jesus teach us to pray?

Jesus teaches us to pray not only with the Our Father but also when he prays. In this way he teaches us, in addition to the content, the dispositions necessary for every true prayer: purity of heart that seeks the Kingdom and forgives one's enemies, bold and filial faith that goes beyond what we feel and understand, and watchfulness that protects the disciple from temptation.

#### 545. Why is our prayer efficacious?

Our prayer is efficacious because it is united in faith with the prayer of Jesus. In him Christian prayer becomes a communion of love with the Father. In this way we can present our petitions to God and be heard: "Ask and you will receive that your joy may be full" (John 16:24).

#### 546. How did the Virgin Mary pray?

Mary's prayer was characterized by faith and by the generous offering of her whole being to God. The Mother of Jesus is also the new Eve, the "Mother of all the living". She prays to Jesus for the needs of all people.

#### 547. Is there a prayer of Mary in the Gospel?

Along with the prayer of Mary at Cana in Galilee, the Gospel gives us the Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55) which is the song both of the Mother of God and of the Church, the joyous thanksgiving that rises from the hearts of the poor because their hope is met by the fulfillment of the divine promises.


